Is there a possibility to download the videos?

Unfortunately due to copyright matters we cannot offer to download the videos.

Why should I upgrade into the verified track?

Upgrading into the verified track has a lot of benefits. First and foremost you will receive a certificate in the end. Also the graded parts of this course will only be available for verified users. That means that only verified users can access all of the revision questions and the final exam. Lastly the course content will not be accessible for audit users after the course end date.

When is the last day to upgrade for the verified track?

You can upgrade into the verified track until **February 03, 2023 at 23:59 UTC**.

What content will be available for me if I decide to stay as an audit learner?

Audit users only have access to the lecture videos, some revision questions and the recommended sources. They will get six weeks after enrolling to see and work on the content unlocked to them. The course content will not be accessible after the course end date.

Which parts of the course are graded?

The recap quizzes below each video, and the programming exercises are ungraded and therefore open for all learners to take part in. All other content is graded and only available for learners in the verified track.

What do I have to do to pass the course?

To pass the course you need 60% of the points of exercise questions and the final exam. The weight of the exercise questions is 40% of the final grade, the weight of the final exam is 60%. If you leave out exercise questions you can still receive 60% of the points. But we strongly recommend answering all the exercise questions because they are an important part of the learning process.

Why is the due date of the quiz questions and the exam earlier than the course end date?

The course end date is a technical date where the course closes. Until this date the course is going to be archived.

Why can't I access all of the recap questions and the final exam?

Some of the recap questions and the final exam are graded and therefore only available for verified users.

What happens when not enough peers review my assignment?

There's no need to worry if your assignment doesn't get corrected by enough peers. If there aren't enough reviews after the due date the course team will correct your assignment. This should only happen in individual cases. Please be fair and review your peers assignments.

How much time do I have for the final exam?

The final exam will be open from March 01, 2019 at 8:00 UTC until March 08, 2019 09:00 UTC. In this time span you have one hour time to finish the exam.
