## **GRADING AND CERTIFICATES**

If you would like to earn a certificate for this course, it is mandatory for you to join the verified track and complete the following:

- **Revision questions:** After watching the lecture videos in the respective weeks you will be asked to answer a series of revision questions. Please note that every subsection contains graded questions as well as ungraded ones.
- Three-step-assignment: The assignment will be conducted as a cultural heritage case study which will be undertaken on a step by step basis. You will be asked to select a case study city with which you are already familiar and where the cultural heritage is under threat. After receiving the contents of the weeks 3, 4 and 5, you will be asked to apply the knowledge that you have attained to your chosen case study. Your assignments will be evaluated through a peer review procedure by three other participants (whilst, at the same time, you will be asked to evaluate other assignments).

Please note that all graded content is only available for verified users. Your final grade will be constituted by the following: 15% revision questions, 85% three-step-assignment.

To obtain a certificate you are required to have at least 60% of the total points.

There is no weekly deadline for each week's tasks. You will be eligible for a certificate as long as you complete all the tasks by **October 31, 2021**.

Please note that the deadline for the upgrade to the verified track is **October 18**, **2021**!
